



### EAST CAROLINA

The Benjamin House

Pays for site preparation, including ground breaking, to build a home for handicapped young adults.

### UGANDA

Diocese of Lango  
Apoi Rural Water Project

Establishes a safe, clean water source for a lakeside community with a high rate of infection from intestinal *bilharzia*. Grant monies will also provide training in the use and maintenance of the water system.



### OKLAHOMA

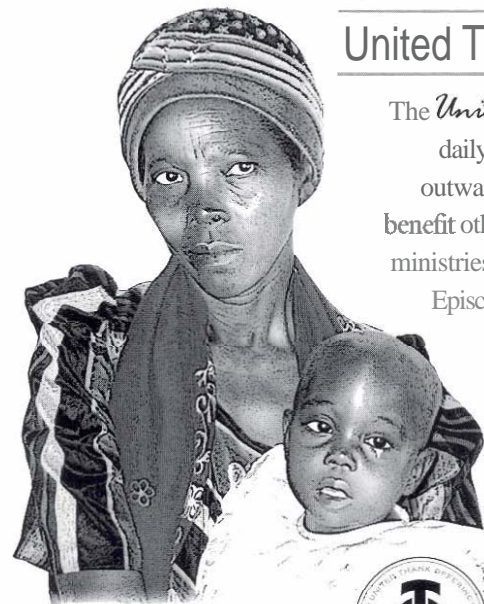
Whirlwind Mission of the Holy Family

Expands a Native American ministry that addresses issues of family dysfunction, substance abuse, and discrimination. The grant will furnish the kitchen, including appliances, and will purchase tables and chairs for their meeting room.

### WESTERN MASSACHUSETTS

The Ark Episcopal Center

Helps construct a new mission and worship space at the University of Massachusetts. Students will have access to a class on the homeless in America, a South African daycare alliance, development of new liturgical music, and an undergraduate learning initiative entitled "Belief."



### WYOMING

Canterbury House

Renovates existing space in a campus ministry house in Laramie to provide handicapped accessibility. This grant will build a new bathroom and a ramp entrance for wheelchair users.

### IGLESIA ANGLICANA DEL CONO SUR DE AMERICA

Diocese of Uruguay  
San Esteban AIDS Support Project

Purchases a house in Montevideo to serve as a church building for a congregation that now meets in someone's house and to provide lodging for up to eight people suffering from AIDS who receive outpatient treatment in this city.

### INDIANAPOLIS

St. Christopher's Child Care Ministry

Helps start a new program for disadvantaged children and families, including a licensed child care center, health screening and case coordination, and after-school and summer enrichment programs.
